- 4. All real Americans support the second amendment; people should be allowed to carry their guns wherever they want.
- 5. I support the President's ban on travelers from the Middle East; after all, the 9-11 hijackers were all Muslims.
- 6. The last Oscar nominations did not include any minority actors. That just shows how racist Hollywood really is.
- 7. Just because each of the past four years has been the hottest on record does not prove that the earth is getting warmer.
